Place value to six digits, money, rounding, ordinals, Roman numerals, problem solving, addition and subtraction with/without re-grouping, estimation, geometry (solids, plane figures, slides, flips, turns, angles), graphs (charts, pictographs, coordinates) measurement (length, perimeter), multiplication and division facts to 12 x 12 and 144. 12, fractions, decimals, addition and subtraction (to thousandth column) of decimals in hundredths, rounding decimals, dividing and multiplying up to three digits by two digits with/without remainders, introduction of protractor.

- KEYBOARDING:** Mavis Beacon Teaches Typing; Story Book Weaver – Basic skills in Microsoft Word software open, save, print, centering a title, indenting a paragraph (tab), downloading to a Word document. (Goal = 15 wpm).
- ART:** Line, concepts of the colour wheel and warm and cool colours, analogous, complimentary, and contrasting colours, positive and negative space, exploring works of Art, pointillism, multi-media work, Christmas crafts and Mother’s Day, papier-mâché penguins, weaving/silhouettes, posters, mosaics, Native art – tepees, totem poles, canoes, paper tissue flowers, black/white drawings (shading), animal sketches, story quilts, drawing fruits (inside and out).
- MUSIC:** Theory: Time signatures; note values; note names - treble and bass; notation - bar lines, note stems, treble and bass clefs, staff; scale intervals - solfege; reading bars of music by note and value; sound recognition - high versus low; rhythm patterns - notating rhythms dictated; instruments in the orchestra; listening –WSO orchestra.
- Vocal: Action songs, rounds, unison singing, simple two part songs, two part harmony, singing posture, vocal production, choral warm-ups.
Instrumental: Recorder.
