**MATHEMATICS:** Houghton Mifflin Mathematics 5 (Units 1- 14 Inclusive)  
Numeration, place value to nine digits, rounding, decimals to hundredths, problem solving, addition and subtraction with and without regrouping, multiplication up to four digits, division up to four digits by one digit, measurement, length, perimeter, area, volume capacity, mass, angles, and problem solving. Fractions and ratios, graphing, decimal multiplication and division, geometry, slides, turns, flips, decimal, regrouping, decimal additions, subtraction, and multiplication. Number theory, Multiples, divisibility, factors order of operations and problem solving.
