- MUSIC:** Instrumental Music: assembling instruments, care of instruments, playing posture, embouchure formation, and breathing. Note values: whole, quarter, half, dotted half. Rests: whole, half, quarter. Musical terms: measure, bar line, flat, accent, breath mark, repeat sign, fermata, tie, solo, soli, tutti, round, sharp, slur, pick-up note. Notes: B Concert scale and pieces for performances.
- PHYSICAL EDUCATION:** Instructions, rules, strategy and play in the following: Soccer, Volleyball, Basketball, Floor Hockey, Track & Field and Football, G.L.O., Baseball, and organized mini games. Goals: Creative, Intellectual and Decisional. Emphasis will be on flexibility, lifetime health and fitness, muscular fitness and motor proficiency. Christian Perspective: Approaching physical education from a Christian perspective, realizing we are created in God's image and that as Christians we are temples of the Holy Spirit so we must treat our bodies carefully.
- ART:** A study of five elements of design with various lessons focusing on these elements. Also a study of principals of design (rhythm, balance, harmony etc.) Students are encouraged to study and experiment with the various art media such as sketching, painting, 3-Dimensional art. Various cultural influences are analyzed as well as prominent pieces of art history.
