- Recognize and print numerals (required to 30, encouraged to 100)
- Awareness of addition and subtraction in concrete demonstrations
- Identify and sort 2-D shapes and 3-D objects
- Spatial sense vocabulary – words describing position, movement, distance, shape and comparison
- Measurement – direct, indirect, capacity, time
- Patterning – identify, extend
- Estimation
- Important numbers – addresses, birthdays, telephone numbers, days of school
- Number words to ten
